Sub: Higher Education – Incentive increments to Assistant Librarian / College Librarians who acquired Ph.D. degree prior to 01.01.2006 - Clarification – Issued.

I am directed to invite your attention to the references cited and to clarify that the Assistant Librarian / College Librarians who acquired Ph.D. prior to 01.01.2006 shall be allowed three non-compounded advance increments in the revised UGC scales of pay, as ordered in G.O.(Ms) No.350, Higher Education Department, dated 09.09.2009, since there was no provision for sanction of advance increment to the Assistant Librarian / College Librarians till 31.12.2005 i.e in the pre-revised UGC scales of pay. Further, the monetary benefit of the non-compounded advance increments to those Assistant Librarian / College Librarians shall be allowed with effect from 01.09.2008 or from the date of acquiring of Ph.D., whichever is later, as provided in the Regulations 9.0 of the UGC Regulations, 2010.
